QUALITY LEVEL: 3 Quality Assurance Through Attributes (GPO PUB 310.1, effective May 1979 (Rev. 9-19)) applies.

DESCRIPTION:

SPECIFICATIONS WILL APPLY EQUALLY TO BOTH JACKETS EXCEPT AS NOTED HEREIN.

DIGITAL PRINTING ACCEPTABLE.

At contractor's option, the product may be produced via conventional offset or digital printing provided that Quality Level 3 standards are maintained. Final output must be a minimum of 150 line screen and at a minimum resolution of 1200 x 1200 x 1 bit or 600 x 600 x 4 bit depth technology.

Jacket 425-049

PRINTING: 4-part snapsets print black ink face and back (head to foot) with type/line matter, and screen tints. All parts must register.

CONSTRUCTION: Drill two 1/4" diameter holes (through printed sheets 2, 3, and 4 only), 2-3/4" center to center, positioned 3/8" from stub perforation to center of holes, and centered in 8-1/2" dimension.

CHANGES: Parts 1-4 (face is common on all parts, back is common on all parts).

CARBON PAPER: Interleave between all parts with Black one time carbon paper. Carbon must be of sufficient density and graded sensitivity to insure clear, legible copies on all parts when part 1 is filled in by manual/electric typewriter and/or ball-point pen. Carbon coverage is 8-1/2 x 10-5/8" (3/8" short at bottom). Must be able to produce (1) copy through all parts after storage of twelve (12) months.

STUB: Sets are to be held together at the 8-1/2" top by a 1/2" to 1" internally glued or pasted, perforated stub.

PRINTING: 3-Part carbonless snapsets; Part 1 prints in Black ink, face and back (head to head). Part 2 prints in Pantone 469 Brown face only. Part 3 prints in Pantone 334 Green on face and back (head to head). Marginal changes (copy designations) in red ink on all parts. Images consist of type/rule matter, screen tints, and logo. All parts must register.

STUB: Sets are held together at the 8-1/2" top by a 1/2" to 1" internally glued or pasted, perforated stub.

DRILLING: Drill 2 holes through all parts, 1/4" in diameter, 2-3/4" center to center; centered on the 8-1/2" dimension. Center of holes are 3/8" from stub perforation.

WARRANTY: Contract Clause 15, "Warranty", of GPO Contract Terms (GPO Publication 310.2, effective December 1, 1987 (Rev. 01-18)) is amended for the solicitation to the effect that the warranty period is EXTENDED from 120 days to one calendar year from the date the check is tendered as final payment. All other provisions remain the same.

Contractor to download the Labeling and Marking Specifications form (GPO Form 905, R. 7-15) from gpo.gov, fill in appropriate blanks, and attach to shipping containers.

Prior to image processing, the contractor shall perform a basic check (preflight) of the furnished media and publishing files to assure correct output of the required reproduction image. Any errors, media damage, or data corruption that might interfere with proper file image processing must be reported to the contract administrator.

The contractor shall create or change any necessary trapping, set proper screen angles and screen frequency, and define file output selection for the imaging device being utilized. Furnished files must be imaged as necessary to meet the assigned quality level.

E-MAIL PROOFS (indicate margins): CONTRACTOR MUST NOT PRINT PRIOR TO RECEIVING AN "OK TO PRINT". One set of E-Mailed Electronic Page Proofs. Contractor to submit one "Press Quality" PDF "soft" proof (for content only) using the same Raster Image Processor (RIP) that will be used to produce the final printed product. PDF proof will be evaluated for text flow, image position, and color breaks. Proof will not be used for color match.

E-Mailed proofs (marked with Jacket/Req. Number plus return name and E-Mail address) directly to the Agency at Cyrus.Benson@opm.gov, and cc: lhollingsworth@gpo.gov. Contractor must call GPO Contract Compliance Section at (202) 512-0520 immediately upon E-Mailing proofs and immediately upon receiving the returned proofs (or OK E-Mail) back from the Department. Proofs will be withheld not more than (3) workdays from receipt at the Department to receipt in the contractor's plant.

Jacket 425-049 only:

PRIOR TO PRODUCTION SAMPLES: Prior to the commencement of production of the contract production quantity, the contractor shall submit two (2) sample sets to: Cyrus Benson, Room B-427, 202.936.0401, U.S. Office of Personnel Management, 1900 E Street, NW, Washington, DC 20415, Inside Delivery Required.

Samples will be tested for conformance of material(s) and will be tested for usage on the specified equipment and/or for construction. The container and accompanying documentation shall be marked **PREPRODUCTION SAMPLES** and shall include the GPO jacket, purchase order, and program numbers. The samples must be submitted in sufficient time to allow Government testing of the samples and production and shipment in accordance with the shipping schedule.

The Government will approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the samples within (2) workdays of the receipt thereof. Approval or conditional approval shall not relieve the contractor from complying with the specifications and all other terms and conditions of the contract. A conditional approval shall state any further action required by the contractor. A notice of disapproval shall state the reasons therefor.

If the samples are disapproved by the Government, the Government, at its option, may require the contractor to submit additional samples for inspection and test, in the time and under the terms and conditions specified in the notice of rejection. Such additional samples shall be furnished, and necessary changes made, at no additional cost to the Government and with no extension in the shipping schedule. The Government will require the time specified above to inspect and test any additional samples required.

In the event the additional samples are disapproved by the Government, the contractor shall be deemed to have failed to make delivery within the meaning of the default clause in which event this contract shall be subject to termination for default, provided however, that the failure of the Government to terminate the contract for default in such event shall not relieve the contractor of the responsibility to deliver the contract quantities in accordance with the shipping schedule.

In the event the Government fails to approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the samples within the time specified, the Contracting Officer shall automatically extend the shipping schedule in accordance with Contract Clause 12, "Notice of Compliance with Schedules," of GPO Contract Terms (GPO Publication 310.2, effective December 1, 1987 (Rev. 01-18)).

Manufacture of the final product prior to approval of the sample submitted is at the contractor's risk. Samples will not be returned to the contractor. All costs, including the costs of all samples shall be included in the contract price for the production quantity.

All samples shall be manufactured at the facilities in which the contract production quantities are to be manufactured.

The notice must provide all applicable tracking numbers, shipping method, and Title. Contractor must be able to provide copies of all delivery, mailing, and shipping receipts upon agency request.

Prior to award, contractor may be required to provide information related to specific equipment that will be used for production.

PREAWARD SURVEY: In order to determine the responsibility of the prime contractor or any subcontractor, the Government reserves the right to conduct an on-site pre-award survey at the contractor's/subcontractor's facility or to require other evidence of technical, production, managerial, financial, and similar abilities to perform, prior to the award of a contract. As part of the financial determination, the low contractor may be required to provide one or more of the following financial documents:

- 1) Most recent profit and loss statement
- 2) Most recent Balance Sheet
- 3) Statement of cash flows
- 4) Current official bank statement
- 5) Current lines of credit (with amounts available)
- 6) Letter of commitment from paper supplier(s)
- 7) Letter of commitment from any subcontractor

The documents will be reviewed to validate that adequate financial resources are available to perform the contract requirements. Documents submitted will be kept confidential, and used only for the determination of responsibility by the Government. Failure to provide the requested information in a timely manner may result in the Contracting Officer not having adequate information to reach an affirmative determination of responsibility.
